He has represented India's Ministry of Finance in Japan in the capacity of Minister (Economic & Commercial), Embassy of India, Tokyo. Mr. Singh was also Chairman & MD, Maharashtra State Electricity Transmission Company Limited and Director/ Deputy Secretary, Government of India and serves on the Board of Directors of Power Exchange India Limited and Oriental Hotels Limited
